Report on Business

Pasinex Resources Limited is a Toronto-based mining company focused on the exploration and production of high-grade zinc. The Company owns 100% of Horzum A.Ş., which operates the Pinargözü Mine in Türkiye. Pinargözü is

a producing, high-grade zinc mine with ore grades typically ranging from 30% to 50%, selling directly to zinc smelters and refiners through commodity brokers. Over the past decade, operations at Pinargözü have mined more than 200,000 tonnes of ore, produced over 160 million pounds of zinc, and generated more than CAD \$125 million in sales.

The Company also owns 100% of the Sarıkaya lead-zinc operating license in Kayseri Province, Türkiye, a project with significant near-term production potential. Sarıkaya is already producing on a small scale at grades between 30% and 50% zinc.

In the United States, Pasinex holds a 51% interest in the Gunman Project in Nevada, a high-grade zinc exploration property with historical grades between 14% and 24%.

The Company filed its audited annual financial statements and MD&A and issued one news release during the month, as follows:

- (i) July 29th, 2026 – The Company filed its audited annual financial statements, MD&A and officer certifications for the period ended March 31st, 2026, on SEDAR;
- (ii) July 30th, 2026 – ‘Pasinex Announces Audited Financial Results for the Fifteen-Month Period Ended March 31, 2026 – Completes Strategic Acquisitions, Reduces Shareholder Loans and Strengthens Financial Position.’

The Company has now improved its financial position by reducing its existing liabilities.

The Company has not completed a current technical report that includes a mineral resource estimate as defined by the Mineral Resources and Reserves, Definitions and Guidelines prepared by the CIM Standing Committee on Reserve Definitions and adopted by CIM Council. The Company has no intention of completing a NI 43-101 compliant technical report.

The Mine has been operating on a single shift per day, with approximately 200 tonnes of zinc sulphide material produced per month.
