On July 28, 2026, the Issuer announced a non-brokered private placement for aggregate gross proceeds of up to \$337,500 through the proposed sale of up to 4,500,000 flow-through units at a price of \$0.075 per unit. Each unit is expected to consist of one critical flow-through common share and one common share purchase warrant. Each warrant is expected to entitle the holder to acquire one additional common share at an exercise price of \$0.10 for three years from the closing date.

The Issuer stated that the gross proceeds are intended to be used to incur eligible Canadian exploration expenses and flow-through critical mineral mining expenditures. The proposed offering remained subject to regulatory approval, including approval of the Canadian Securities Exchange. No finder's fees are expected to be paid in connection with the offering. Management also continued general corporate operations and its review of historical exploration data and geological information relating to the Lamont Lake Uranium Project.

Management worked on the activities described in item 1, including arranging and announcing the proposed flow-through private placement and continuing its technical review of the Lamont Lake Uranium Project.

No new drilling or exploration program was commenced during the month. The Issuer's technical team continued to review historical exploration data

and geological information relating to the Lamont Lake Uranium Project to assist in defining a future exploration program.
