The Issuer is engaged in the acquisition, exploration and development of mineral properties. The Issuer's principal exploration and development target is the exploration for gold in the Northwest Territories, where the Issuer holds a 100% interest in the Mon Gold Property located 45 kilometres north of Yellowknife. The Company controls thirteen Mining Leases encompassing 494.28 hectares, as well as a contiguous Mineral Claim (NDM3) comprising an additional 127.75 hectares.

In July 2026 management's primary focus was on the preparation of various management plans, and responses to regulatory queries and required changes to the plans.

In July the Issuer's 20-man camp was assembled and is fully operational. The Issuer completed standard equipment maintenance. Blast rock was cleared from the mill pad and the Issuer commenced construction of a road to the dry stack tailings facility with this material. The Issuer is ready to commence mill assembly, and mining as the mill nears completion, once management plans are approved.

During July 2026, management's principal activities consisted of, but were not limited to, discussion on and the preparation of necessary documentation in respect of:

- (a) Planning and monitoring exploration and development at the Mon Gold Property;**
- (b) Preparing Construction Plans and responding to queries and required changes to various operations management plans which are pending approval from the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board;**
- (c) The Issuer's Annual General Meeting was held on July 23; all resolutions detailed in the Company's information circular were approved by shareholders, and no other business was put forward.**
- (d) Examining other mineral exploration opportunities;**
- (e) General management and administrative matters.**
