#### **Report on Business**

1. Provide a general overview and discussion of the development of the Issuer’s business and operations over the previous month. Where the Issuer was inactive disclose this fact.

**McFarlane Lake Mining Limited is a gold exploration company focused on advancing its portfolio of mineral properties. Its primary holding is the recently acquired Juby Gold Project located near the Timmins gold camp in the southern Abitibi greenstone belt of Ontario. Its other exploration properties include the McMillan and Mongowin gold properties, both of which have seen past production, located approximately 70 km west of Sudbury, Ontario. McFarlane also owns the Michaud/Munro property, located 115 km east of Timmins along the so-called ‘Golden Highway’.**

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

**During July 2026, the Company focused on the exploration program for its Juby Gold Project. During the month, the Company continued drilling and environmental baseline studies on the property. The Company also announced US\$10.96 million of outstanding debentures were repaid with funds from the exercise of warrants and the \$6.75 million private placement led by strategic investors Michael Gentile and Pierre Beaudoin that closed in June 2026.**

**During July 2026, the Company continued drilling on its Juby Gold Project. The drill program was initiated in December 2025 and is expected to total approximately 15,000 metres (“m”). The drilling program commenced at the 826 Zone and now includes the Golden Lake Zone.**

The program's strategy is to prioritize drilling areas within the Juby Gold Project that can add significant gold ounces to the gold resource, leveraging McFarlane's knowledge from its latest geological review. The Juby Gold Project is defined by four gold resource areas: Juby, Golden Lake, Big Dome, and Hydro Creek. Golden Lake and Juby have the most significant potential to add ounces to the existing resource. The drill program is also investigating the 826 Zone, which is located to the southwest of the existing defined resource.

On July 23, 2026, the Company released additional results from its diamond-drilling exploration campaign. From recent exploration drilling the strike length of gold mineralization has now extended to 1.9 kilometers in length from a previously announced 0.75 km. Further holes GL26-83 and GL26-83A demonstrate a widening of the mineralization from the existing open pit shell, this not only increases revenue potential but also favourably affects the economics of extraction.

The most western drilled hole extends the strike to 1.9 km. Assays from hole GL26-87 (93 m of 0.89 g/t gold) have confirmed a significant intersection on the most western hole drilled in the program on the Golden Lake deposit. This intersection not only extends the strike length to 1.9 km but demonstrates the deposit remains open to the west and at depth in this area.

The new mineralized lense widens the open pit outline in "Hanging Wall". Commencing at 34 m from surfaces Hole GL- 83A intersected 179.10 m of 0.87 g/t gold which includes 15.55 m of 1.58 g/t gold and 6.9 m of 2.33 g/t gold. Commencing at 65.85 m from surface Hole GL-83 intersected 155 m of 0.9 g/t gold which includes 11.4 m of 2.37 g/t gold. Both holes intersected gold mineralization close to surface and about 250 meters before its targeted mineralized area. Mineralization in the hanging wall area of the pit outline was unexpected and but now creates an opportunity to step back and test the extension (widening) in this area.
